A logo for The Beacon homeless day resource center has been chosen!



- **The Starburst** represents light and hope, two concepts closely related to the word "beacon" and central to what The Beacon brings to the community it serves. The burst is rising over the roof-line, suggesting a sunrise & a new day.
- **The Roof-line** is a powerful symbol of shelter, security, safety, and home.
- **The Color** is a deep medium blue, which conveys a feeling of calm, reliability, strength, and safety – all values we want The Beacon to communicate to both the homeless community and to The Beacon's supporters and staff.

The Story that is communicated through the visual graphic is "many needs will be met under one roof" and the tagline ("Hope Shines Here") conveys a sense of promise that one can find help in this place.
